



JOB DESCRIPTION

Title of Post: 1:1 Support Worker

Purpose of Job: To provide individual care and support to a resident with special needs. This includes support to participate in indoor and outdoor Workshops and other activities. Additionally, there will be an element of supporting the Resident within the House.

Responsible to: House Co-ordinator

Responsible for: Resident with special needs

Background:

Owing to his special needs, a male resident needs support to participate in his weekly programme over a 5-day period. The resident has an active programme and workshops include both indoor and outdoor working. Additionally, once a week the Resident participates in Hill Walking Group.

Hours of Duty:

Monday – Friday (9:00am -5:00pm).

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Overall responsibility for the care and wellbeing of the resident including any personal care needs required.
- Supporting the Resident to engage in his daily programme including attending morning and afternoon workshops as well as other activities.
- Attending Community Festivals and events with the Resident.
- Supporting the Resident to implement Communication Aids throughout the day.
- Supporting the Resident in accordance with his personal care plan and under instruction of the House Co-ordinator.
- Responsibility for the Resident's room; making it a safe, tidy and personal environment.
- Collaborating with other workers in the house and workshops.
- Working in accordance with Corbenic's policies and procedures.

PERSON SPECIFICATION

Qualifications, Experience and Personal Qualities

The successful candidate will have:

- Experience in providing care and support to people with learning disabilities, preferably with qualifications in this area.
- Good communication and interpersonal skills.
- Willingness to work in a range of indoor and outdoor settings as dictated by the schedule of the individual.
- A good level of fitness and ability to participate in outdoor activities.
- Willingness to work as part of a wider team providing the highest quality care and support.
- Willingness to participate in training relevant to the post.
- Willingness to work under their own initiative, taking ownership and responsibility for their role.
- A flexible and patient approach.
